

Bootlake Summer Camp 2016 Personal Camping Gear Checklist

Use this list to make sure you have everything you need for a great time at camp.

Make one check mark when you have it and one check mark when you pack it.

All items should be marked with name. **This list is a guide and can be adjusted as needed. Those items underlined are highly recommended or required.**

Travel Day

- Scout uniform - no neckerchief
Scouts always travel to and from camp in Scout uniform.
- Prescription medicine
(must be in original container and given to adult leader at check-in)
- Health Forms please try to turn in before we leave for camp if possible
- Bag Lunch will have lunch on trip to Bootlake
- Cracker Barrel Item
(snack to share with the troop)

NO SODA/POP CANS/BOTTLES at POINT
NO FOOD/SNACKS/GUM IN TENTS

Day Pack

(Scouts required to use & carry Day Pack daily)

- Water bottle
- Scout Handbook in ZipLock Bag
- Sun screen
- Mosquito repellent (non-aerosol)
- Hat
- Sun glasses
- Flash light and/or head lamp
& extra batteries
- Poncho or raincoat with hood
- Light jacket
- Pens and pencils
- Notebook in ZipLock Bag

- Swimsuit can be left in boat house
- Towel can be left in boat house

Do Not Bring

- Sheath knives
- Shooting sports equipment or ammo
- NO SODA/POP cans/bottles at the Point
- Electronic games (only used during trip to camp)
- Music players (only used during trip to camp)
- Cell phones (only used during trip to camp)
- Fireworks of any kind

Remember

- Food is NOT allowed in tents
- Flames are NOT allowed in tents

Back pack or Sport bag

- Sleeping bag
- Foam pad or air mattress
- Pillow
- Mess kit (plate, bowl & cup; knife, fork & spoon)
- Toiletry kit containing
toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, soap, hand towel (can be put in ziplock bag)
- Pocket knife & sharpening stone
- Totin' Chip Card
(required if you carry or use a knife)
- Camera or single use camera
- Mosquito netting – head net
- Changes of underwear (4)
- Changes of socks (3) (Good pairs of “Smart Wool” type socks, White athletic socks are not suggested as they are not good or easy to dry when they get wet)
- Pants (1)
- Shorts (2)
- T-shirts (3)
- light Long-sleeve shirt
- Sweat shirt, fleece or sweater
- Pajamas
- Watch
- Shoes
- Extra footwear in case muddy or shoes get wet
- Bag for dirty clothes
- Fishing pole and tackle
- your own PFD if you'd like
